Phase 0

WEEKS 1 & 2

Continue to...

- Keep children at home if possible:-
- Support your child/children to continue learning at home
- Communicate with the College and/ or your child's teachers via email wherever possible
- Follow the NSW health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell

Phase 1

WEEKS 3 & 4

Continue to...

- Send your children to school ONE day a week
- Keep your child at home for the other days when not in the scheduled Year group wherever possible
- Be aware which day of the week your child/children should attend
- Follow the College's advice regarding changes to drop off & pick up, including staying in your car when dropping off and picking up children if safe to do so
- Maintain social distancing by avoiding gathering outside of school gates
- Make sure your children have access to lunch and snacks, noting the Canteen is NOT operating at this stage
- Support your children to continue learning at home on remote learning days
- Communicate with the College and/ or your child's teachers via email wherever possible
- Follow the NSW health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell

Phase 2

WEEKS 5 & 6

Continue to...

- Send children to school TWO days a week
- Keep your child at home for the other days when not in the scheduled Year group wherever possible
- Be aware which TWO days of the week your children should attend
- Follow the College's advice regarding changes to drop off & pick up, including staying in your car when dropping off and picking up children if safe to do so
- Use the College Canteen and Uniform Shop as per advice (pre-orders & online orders only)
- Maintain social distancing by avoiding gathering outside of school gates
- Support your children to continue learning at home on remote learning days
- Communicate with the College and/ or your child's teachers via email wherever possible
- Follow the NSW health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell

Phase 3

WEEKS 7 & 8

Continue to...

- Send your children to school all FIVE days of the school week
 - Be aware of advice regarding changes to drop off & pick up
 - Walk your children to the gate if you need to while maintaining social distancing
 - Maintain social distancing by avoiding gathering outside of school gates
 - Access other services that may be operating onsite where they are not restricted by Public Health Orders
 - Use the Canteen and Uniform Shop as advised (pre-orders & online orders)
- BUT PLEASE:**
- Follow the College's advice regarding drop off and pickup
 - Maintain social distancing by avoiding gathering outside of school gates
 - Support your children to continue to learn at home if they are required to learn remotely
 - Communicate with your child's teachers
 - Follow the NSW health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell

Phase 4

WEEKS 9 & 10

Continue to...

- Send your child/children to school EVERY day of the school week
 - Participate in school excursions & inter-school activities
 - Be aware of changing advice regarding drop off & pick up
 - Participate in school based activities such as volunteering in classes, canteen, etc
 - Use services that usually operate at the College
- BUT PLEASE:**
- Follow any updates regarding drop off and pick up
 - Support your children to continue to learn at home if they are required to learn remotely
 - Continue to communicate with your child's teachers
 - Follow the NSW health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell
